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Isaac Bradshaw exhibits upon its face defects which cannot be remedied without recommitting the said account to the same Commissioner. It is ordered that the said account be recommitteed to the said Commissioner who is instructed to receive testimony upon the points reported by him to be disputed.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor make to Thomas Gray an allowance of twenty five dollars for the support of Mary Wade <sup>and</sup> a female African by the name of Bonny

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine state and settle an account current of Silas Sumnerly administration on the estate of Arthur Dole dec<sup>d</sup> and report the same to the Court.

The Last will and Testament of James Barnes dec<sup>d</sup> was proved by the oath of Robert Stephenson and Sally Horn the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and Susanna Barnes the Executrix therein named refusing to take upon herself the burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of Augustine Pope who made oath and together with Emmet Clark and George Hurley his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said James Barnes with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.

Ordered that Weston Pope, Charles Gorderger, George Williams and Giles Barnett or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Barnes dec<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Susan Barnes widow and relict of James Barnes dec<sup>d</sup> appeared in Court and declared that she will not take or accept the provision made for her by the said will or any part thereof, and renounced all benefit which she might claim by the said will.

Kinchin Gray orphan of Benjamin Gray dec<sup>d</sup> with the approbation of the Court made choice of DREWRY BRYANT for his guardian and thereupon the said DREWRY BRYANT together with Joel Williams and Augustine Pope his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of six hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

James Gray orphan of Joseph Gray dec<sup>d</sup> with the approbation of the Court made choice of James Gray for his guardian and thereupon the said James Gray together with Lawrence Cobb his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

The Court doth assign William J. Maget guardian to Arthur Le Maget and Angelina Maget orphan of Nicholas Maget dec<sup>d</sup> and thereupon the said William J. Maget together with James Mellick and Clements Rockwell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs.
