Ordered that William E Daughton render before Master Commissioner Cobb an account of his administration on Nicholas Maget's estate, and that the said Commissioner examine, state and settle the same and make report thereof to Court.

Aubin Middleton Coroner of this County together with James Millikin his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred dollars conditioned according to Law for his administration of the estate of William M Chappell a fugitive.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term. The minutes of the foregoing proceedings were signed by Felix Summersell.
