We also assign unto Eleanor Biddle Lot No. 2 containing forty three and a half acres. Beginning at a post or new corner near the house running due South to a new corner in Elihu Atkins' line, thence along the said Atkins' line to a red oak a variation ther a long she said Atkins' line to a black gum, thence N 54° W to the beginning it being her proportion of said land.

We also assign unto Fanny Biddle Lot No. 3 containing Twenty six acres, beginning at a new corner made in Elihu Atkins' line running N 54° W to a new corner made near the house, thence S 58° W to a new corner made in the Wolfpit Branch, thence up the said Branch to the out boundary in Atkins' line, thence along the said Atkins' line to the beginning it being her proportion of said lands.

We also assign unto Dury Biddle Lot No. 4 containing thirty four acres, Beginning at a new corner made near the House running N 57° E to a new corner made in Rose Swamp thence down the said Swamp to the intersection of the Wolfpit Branch, thence up the said Branch to a new corner made in Lot No. 3 & 4 thence N 58° W to the beginning it being her proportion of said land. Given under our hands this 16<sup>th</sup> of June 1821. Peter Edwards, Henry Dorsey, Aunt Harris.  
On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties.

The persons appointed by an order of Court made December last 1823 to allot to James Harrison and Sally his wife late Sally Fitzhugh one equal fourth part of the negroes conveyed by a Deed of Gift from William Fitzhugh to his children this day made the following report to us. "In obedience to the subpoenae decretum to us directed bearing date December last eighteen hundred and Twenty three, 1823 the undersigned do allot unto James Harrison & wife One negro man Charles, and one girl named Cherry by their paying the sum of forty three dollars and seventy five cents to the other legatees on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December eighteen hundred and Twenty four, this sum of forty three dollars & seventy five cents being that much over their part of the slaves mentioned in the said decree. Given under our hands this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1823. Aunt Harris, Peter Edwards. Bond." Whereupon it is ordered that the said report be confirmed.
