A Writing purporting the last Will and Testament of Simon Boykin dec'd and this day presented in Court and Silas Sumner and Benjamin Griffin being sworn severally deposed and said that they believe the said writing to be wholly written by the Testator. Therefore it is ordered that the same be established as and for the last Will and Testament of the said Simon Boykin dec'd and the same is ordered to be recorded. John Urquhart one of the Executors therein named refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of John Boykin the other Executor therein named who made oath and together with Silas Sumner, James M. Urquhart and John Harris his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of sixty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that John Urquhart, James M. Urquhart, Silas Sumner and David I. Boykin or any three of them being first duly sworn before Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal Estate of Simon Boykin dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that George Ivy, Lewis Harris and John Womack or any two of them do view the view proposed by Elizabeth M. Sumner for turning a road and report to the Court the comparative convenience and inconvenience that will result as well to individuals as to the public in case the road be altered as proposed.

Levi Pope who is charged on oath by a free single woman of this County with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court and on the motion this case is continued till the next Court.

Mary R. Daughtry orphan of Mills Daughtry died with the approbation of the Court made choice of Daniel B. Fern for her guardian and thereupon the said Daniel B. Fern together with Henry Gurley and Jeremiah Cobb his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Harris Gent. who have been duly licensed to practice the Law in the Courts of this Commonwealth on their motion have leave to practice in this Court and thereupon they severally took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the oath of an attorney at Law and the oath to support the Constitution of the United States.
