Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the said report in number and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable forever. and that

On the motion of Arthur Williamson who produced to the Court the coroners receipt for the tax imposed by law, a license is granted him to keep an ordinary at his house in this County till the first day of May next on his giving bond security according to law. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Williamson is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

Ordered that Henry Lenox, John Exum and Willie Hollons or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Round hill causeway and Bridge across the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon a jury to go on the disputed line between Spradley Williams & Theophilus F. Gilliam to run out the line between them according to law.

Ordered that Phineas M. Bailey admr. of William Bailey dec<sup>d</sup> render before Master Commissioner Cobb an account of the said William Bailey admr. on John Harris's estate, which account the said Commissioner is directed to examine state and settle and make report thereof to Court.
