and from aforesaid made to hold firm and stable forever. and that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne by the parties.

Ordered that James D. Maffenberg, Benjamin Cobb, Henry W. Langham, and John Thomas, view the river and banks in and about Jerusalem and report to the next Court the most eligible and proper place for the bridge to cross the said river Atchway, and also that they report any matter or thing concerning the same which may be thought pertinent. And that the Justices of this County be summoned to the next Court to take into consideration ^{the subject}.

On the motion of Hardy Harris who made oath and together with Alexander T. Ecks and Lewis C. Troupant his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Julia Boykin deceased in due form.

Samuel Nicholas nephew of Robert Nicholas dec'd with the approbation of the Court made choice of Robert Gray for her guardian and thereupon the said Robert Gray together with Thomas Gray, Thomas R. Gray and William Ricks his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

On the motion of Samuel Cobb Sheriff of this County Alfred Darden is permitted to qualify as his deputy during his pleasure, and thereupon the said Darden took the several oaths required by Law for his qualification. The Court being of opinion that the said Darden is a man of good honesty, probity and good demeanor.

On the motion of William Ricks who made oath and together with James W. Langham and Robert Ricks Jr. his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis non on the estate of John Harris deceased in due form.

On the motion of Exum Vick who made oath and together with Jacob Sorden and Matthew Vick his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Samuel Vick dec'd in due form.

Ordered that William Ferguson, Richard Sorden, Joseph Sorden and Harvey Magit or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Samuel Vick dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Henry Applewhite is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from Benjamin Cobb's Shop to Carys road in the room of James C. Foster discharged.

Bennett Edwards is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from Dick's Swamp to the Cypress bridge in the room of John Vick discharged.
