At a Court summoned and held for the County of Southampton on the 31st day of May 1824 for the examination of Josiah Jones who stands charged with stealing, taking and carrying away on the night of the eleventh of February last past from the field and place of John Booth one pair of iron traces of the value of \$7 1/2 cents.

The Court being thus constituted the prisoner was set to the bar by the Sheriff of this County who whose custody he was committed and charged with the felony aforesaid, and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises to wit John Booth, Simon Gay and Henry Gay - and the prisoner being fully heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the Prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court of law to be held for this County, and thereupon the prisoner is remanded to jail.

Be it remembered, that John Booth, Simon Gay and Henry Booth here in Court acknowledge themselves indebted unto his Excellency James Pleasant Governor of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office for the sum being in the sum of \$122.33 1/2 cents each to be levied of their respective goods and chattels lands and Tenements and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if they and each of them shall personally appear before the Judge of the Superior Court of Southampton County at the Courthouse of said County on the first day of the next Term of the said Court then and there to give such evidence as they and each of them know in behalf of the Commonwealth against Josiah Jones who stands charged with Larceny and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then this recognition to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
