

old bridge and would admit of one arch less, the bottom of the River is irregular about two thirds or three fourths of the width, water shallower than above, but the remainder of the distance is about 16 feet deep, the Western buttment will of course rest on Col. Truants land and the Eastern will adjoin the old storehouse lot - it will be readily perceived that if the bridge is erected on this spot the road must run immediately in front of the Clerk's Office - The space between the Office and Maguarts lot, is fifty feet which will give 30 feet for a road and leave 20 which may be protected by post in front of the Office as a foot way All of which is respectfully submitted to the Court.
