On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable forever.

The last Will and Testament of Robert Carr de^d was proved by the oath of Amos Stephenson one of the witnesses thereto. And in the motion of Richard Darden the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Joseph Reese for his security entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of Twenty four hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that Amos Stephenson, Thomas Morrell, and Nathan Pope for being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Robert Carr de^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court. Report of the proceeding in District N^o 7 was this day returned & ordered to be returned to the Council guardian to Samuel Whister this day returned an account of said work estate which is ordered to be recorded.
