small Cypress standing in the run of said branch near two ashes, a new

in Capt Richard Blunts line as aforesaid, thence along a new line of
marked trees S 85° E 113 1/2 poles to the first station. Given under our
hands the 9th day of July 1824. Lewis Morrell, Wm. H. Lee, Charles W
Goodwyn, Lill. Mason. Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed
and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made
be held firm and firm and stable forever. And that the costs of this suit
be proportionably borne between the parties.
