This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed by the
interlocutory decree made in this cause at January term 1824. To make sale of the land
therein mentioned made their report in the following words to wit: "In obedience to a decree
of the Court of Southampton County, bearing date January 1824, and hereto annexed.
We the undersigned have sold the land of Catharine Lumsden dec. late Catharine Corbett
daughter of Joshua Corbett dec. upon the terms and conditions specified in the said decree.
wherein Jesse Lankford became the purchaser, for the sum of three hundred and seventy
eight dollars, and he has given bonds in favor of each of the wards, or orphans according
to said decree as will appear by the annexed receipts, which we pray may be taken and
recorded as a part of our report. We have also in further obedience of said decree,
divided the negroes therein mentioned in the following manner to wit:
Lot Sept: 1. Ditory valued at \$275.00 allotted to Jacob Corbett. to pay Lot N^o 2 \$5.00
Lot N^o 3 \$5.00. Lot N^o 4 \$55.00. and to Lot N^o 5 \$30.00 - Lot N^o 2. valued at
\$175.00. Tenney assigned to William Corbett. to receive from Lot N^o 1 \$5.00.
Lot N^o 3. Tom valued at \$175.00 allotted to Louisa Corbett to receive from Lot N^o 1
\$5.00. Lot N^o 4. Kella valued at \$125.00 allotted to Joshua Lumsden to receive
from Lot N^o 1. \$55.00 - Lot N^o 5. Minerva and Vinna two children valued at \$150.00
allotted to Nancy Corbett to receive from Lot N^o 1 \$30.00. all of which is respectfully
Submitted. Given under our hands this 4th day of March 1824. Cam Bonus.
William Soyner John Morris. On consideration whereof and by consent of parties
it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made
be held stable and binding forever, and that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne
between the parties -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 10 O'Clock.
