Yet upon this condition that if they are each of them severally personally appear before the Justices of our County Court of Southampton at the Courthouse on tomorrow morning by ten o'clock of that day then and there such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Richard Harrison Jr who stands charged with feloniously shooting and murdering a certain Joseph Marks late of this County and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court that the above recognizances be void or else to remain in full force and virtue —

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 O'Clock.

A Court of Quarter Session continued and held for the County of Southampton on the 15th day of August 1824.

Present Benjamin Cobb, Benjamin Griffin, Dan Powers,

Robert Goodwin and Jacob Barnes 3 Gent.

Richard Harrison Jr who stands charged with feloniously shooting and murdering a certain Joseph Marks late of this County on or about the 6th day of July last past, was this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony and murder aforesaid, and therupon one other witness was sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises, court Howell Harris. The evidence being closed on behalf of the Commonwealth and the prisoner being fully heard by John W Mason his Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are unanimously of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court of Law to be held for this County. And therupon the prisoner is remanded to jail —

Be it remembered that Charles J. Hawkins, Parthenia Thorpe, James Newton, James Harrison, Elifton Harrison, Elias W. Dilly, Harley Foster, Shadrack Newton, Thomas and William Willyford, John Hammard, Henry Battle, Benjamin Turner, Presley Barnes, and Howell Harris here severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto James Pleasant Esq. Governor of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office for the time being in the sum of £333.33 $\frac{1}{3}$ cents each of their respective goods and chattels, leases and tenements to be levied and recovered by our said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.
