Yet upon this condition that if they and each of them severally personally appear before the Justices of our County Court of Southampton at the Court house on tomorrow morning by Ten O'clock of that day, then and there such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Richard Harrison Jr who stands charged with feloniously shooting and murdering a certain Joseph Marks late of this County and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance be void or else to remain in full force and virtue —

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 O'clock. The minutes of the foregoing proceedings were signed by Benj. Cobb

A Court of Quarter Sessions continued and held for the County of Southampton on the 15th day of August 1824.

Present Benjamin Cobb, Benjamin Griffin, Levi Bowers, Robert Goodwyne and Jacob Barnes Justs.

Richard Harrison Jr who stands charged with feloniously shooting and murdering a certain Joseph Marks late of this County on or about the 6th day of July last past, was this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony and murder aforesaid, and thereupon one other witness was sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises, to wit Howell Harris. The evidence being closed on behalf of the Commonwealth and the prisoner being fully heard by John W. Mason his learned Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are unanimously of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court of Law to be holden for this County. And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to jail —
