infant defendants to defend them in this suit. And the report the cause was docketed
by consent of parties with the assent of the court and was heard on the bill, answer, exhibits
filed and argument of counsel. Whereupon it appearing to the court that the com-
plainant, Elas Sumnerell, did purchase of William A Boykin in his lifetime about
of land lying in this county containing two hundred acres and four parts into pos-
session of the same by the said William A Boykin in his lifetime, and paid in part
for the said land the sum of five hundred dollars, and it appearing that the
said land is not worth more at a fair and just valuation, than Twenty shillings
per acre. It is therefore adjudged, ordered and decreed that Elas Sumnerell
the complainant pay the sum of fifty pounds Virginia currency to the guardians of
the infant defendants except one sixth part thereof, which is adjudged to the defendant
Dorcas in lieu of her dower in said lands. And it is moreover decreed, that the
said Dorcas do make to the said complainant a legal conveyance of her dower
interest in said land, and that the infant defendants do respectively as they arrive to
the age of Twenty one years make a legal conveyance in fee simple of their interest
in said lands to the complainant Elas Sumnerell. And six months are reserved
to the infant defendants after they arrive to lawful age to contest this decree.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 o'clock.
