A List of the several Deeds &c. admitted to record by the Clerk in his Office since the last Term was at this day returned and examined by the Court and ordered to be recorded among the proceedings of the day.

George Camp who is bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the Complaint of Polly Beale against him for breach of the Peace this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance, and thereupon the said Polly Beale being solemnly called and not appearing it is ordered that the Complaint be dismissed.

On the motion of Thomas Applewhite who made oath and together with Henry Mason and Benjamin Applewhite his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Ansdem Reed dec^d in due form.
