Malcolm L. Bailey orphan of Edward Bailey dec. with the approbation of the Court made choice of Philip L. Burt for his guardian and thereupon the said Philip L. Burt together with James A. Bailey and John Brown his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond with the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned accordingly &c.

Purdy Bradshaw who is bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of Tabitha Dole against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and thereupon the said Tabitha Dole being sworn and examined and examined and the said Purdy Bradshaw fully heard. It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Purdy Bradshaw give security for his keeping the peace for the term of twelve months from this day the said Bradshaw to be bound in the sum of One hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each.

Whereupon the said Purdy Bradshaw together with Robert Renshaw & Jacob Bradshaw his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Excellency James Pleasant Esq. Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth the said Purdy Bradshaw in the sum of One hundred dollars, and his said securities in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Purdy Bradshaw shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Tabitha Dole for the term of twelve months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.

Benjamin Barnes who is bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of George Rayford against him for a breach of the peace, being solemnly called and not appearing, It is ordered that the said recognizance be continued till the next Court.
