 remaining two thirds of said land to be sold immediately as also the reversions of the
 widows dower, to be sold at her death, taking from the purchaser, eight bonds with good
 security for the amount of the purchase money. That they make a deed to the purchaser and
 make report to this Court how they have executed this order in order to a final decree.

 executed this decree make report to the Court in order to a final decree.

Martha, Virginia, Samuel, and William Holmes orphans of Solomon Holmes deceased with the
 assent of the Court made choice of James M. Brughart for their guardian, who together
 with John Brughart his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thou-
 sand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

The Court doth assign Patrick Dole guardian of Demargus W. and Joseph W. Dole children
 of Willie Dole dec'd. and thereupon the said Patrick Dole together with Wiley Dole and Lewis W.
 Dole and his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars
 conditioned according to Law.
