Therefore it is ordered that an attachment be issued against the said Nancy Vick returnable here tomorrow.

The petition and proceedings thereon of Arthur Williamson for leave to build a water grist mill &c is continued till the next Court.

The petition and proceedings thereon of John Rogers for leave to build a water grist mill &c is continued till the next Term.

Benjamin L Drew Gent who hath been appointed a Justice of the Peace for this County by a Commission under the hand of the Governor of this Commonwealth with the Seal of the Commonwealth thereto affixed this day appeared in Court and took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the several oaths of Office, the oath prescribed by the Act, entitled "An act to suppress duelling" and the oath of support the Constitution of the United States.

Ordered that George Ivy, Lewis Harris & Benjamin Harris and Henry Harrison or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Thaddeus Newton dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten O'clock.
