On the motion of James B Wellons who made oath and together with Wiley Wellons and William Ricks his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Lucinda Whitehead deceased with her will heretofore proved and recorded in this Court in due form.

Ordered that Wiley Wellons, Richard Kello, Jr. Richard Pond and Jesse Hicks or any three of them being first duly sworn before a justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Lucinda Whitehead deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of James Jackson It is ordered that William D Powell and Clara his wife be summoned to the next Court to give counter security for the said Clara's administration on Joseph Turners estate.

Benjamin Griffin who hath heretofore been appointed Commissioner of the Revenue in Nottingham Parish in this County this day entered into bond with security in the penalty of One hundred and fifty dollars conditioned according to Law. which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named and ordered to be recorded. The said Benjamin Griffin also took the oaths necessary for his qualification.

William Powell who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of Clary Powell against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared accordingly. Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined and the said Clary Powell and William Powell fully heard, it is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said William Powell give security for his good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the space of twelve calendar months from this day, that is to say, himself in the sum of three hundred dollars with two securities to be bound with him in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars each. And thereupon the said William Powell, with James Foster, James Powell & Henry Bittle his securities here in Court, severally acknowledge themselves indebted unto his excellency James Pleasants Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth, the said William Powell in the sum of three hundred dollars and the said securities in the sum of \$150 each, to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, land and tenements and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.
