the value of 8 1/2 cents

The court being thus constituted the prisoner was set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county
into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid and thereupon
divers witnesses were sworn & examined on behalf of the count touching the premises to wit John
Booth, John Bay & Henry Booth - and the prisoner being fully heard by counsel - The court
after hearing the testimony & all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought
to be tried for said offence at the next Superior court to be holden for this county & thereupon
it is ordered that he be remanded to jail -

Be it remembered that John Booth, John Bay & Henry Booth here in court acknowledged themselves
incited into his Excellency James Pleasant Esq. Governor of this county & his successor in office for the time
being in the sum of \$333:33/3 cents each to be lived of their respective goods & chattels land & tenements
unto the said governor for the use of the county rendered - Yet upon this condition that if
they and each of them shall personally appear before the Judge of the Superior court of this
county at the courthouse of this county on the first day of the next term of said Superior court
then & there to give such evidence as they & each of them know on behalf of the count ag-
st Isaac Jones who stands charged with Larceny & shall not depart thence without leave of
the court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & in law
