And the parties being fully heard, the court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances <sup>of the case</sup> are of opinion that the defendant find security for his good behavior towards all the good citizens of this count<sup>y</sup> for the space of 12 calendar months from this day himself in the sum of \$100 and two securities in the sum of \$50 each & in default thereof that he be <sup>committed</sup> remanded to Jail - whereupon the said Punsie Bradshaw with Robert Rawling & Jacob Bradshaw his securities here in court acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Excellency James Pleasant Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor or chief Magistrate of this count<sup>y</sup> & his Successor in office for the time being the said Bradshaw in the sum of \$100 and his said securities in the sum of \$50 each to be levied of their respective goods & chattels land & tenements & to the said Governor for the use of the count<sup>y</sup> rendered - Yet upon this condition that if the said Punsie Bradshaw shall keep the peace & be of good behavior towards all the good citizens of this count<sup>y</sup> for the space of 12 calendar months from this day but more especially towards Tabitha Cole of this county then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue
