+ Council & others in Boykin & Lohy. Decree as filed by council -
The Jury summoned by virtue of a writ of A. D. Q. about John Boykins since this day made
their report which is ordered to be recorded - and it is ordered that James Taylor agent for the
heirs of Rich. B. Blunt be summoned to the next court to show cause why the said John
Boykin should not have leave to such a water grist mill as petitioned for -

+ Ordered that Edward Butler, Jeremiah Colb & Benj. Colb or any 2 of them let the repairs on

+ Ordered that Silas Summell, Arthur Holleman & John Harris or any 2 of them settle an

+ Ordered that the estate of Bolling H. Barnes dec. be committed to the hand of Jeremiah Colb Sheriff
of this county & that he administer thereon acc. to Law

+ Charles Taylor vice provs by James Turner one of the witness thereto and George B. Edmonds being
sworn depoth and said that he verily believes that the name of the said Richard Williamson who
which is subscribed to said will as a witness, is in the proper hand writing of said Richard Williamson
whereupon it is ordered that the said will be recorded.

+ Bond in Nathl. Newsum Recognizance for a breach of the peace. The defendant appeared in court
according to the condition of his recognizance entered into, and thereupon the securities for his appearance
from their recognizance and undertaking in this behalf are discharged, and the parties being fully
heard. The court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the
said Nathaniel Newsum find security for his good behavior towards all the good citizens of
this county for the space of 12 calendar months from this day himself in the sum of \$500
and two securities in the sum of \$250 each, and in default thereof that he be committed to jail

his securities entered into and acknowledged themselves in due manner.

the use of the bond rendered - Not upon this condition that if the said Nathaniel Newsum
shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all the good citizens of this county for
the space of 12 calendar months from this day but more especially towards Silas Reese of
this county then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -

+ Bond in Powell recognizance for a breach of the peace, for reasons appearing to the court it
is ordered that the writ of Habeas Corpus be awarded against the defendant upon the recognizance
aforesaid returnable here at November court next.
