

Comm. vs Miles Reese. Recognizance for a breach of the peace. The defendant appeared in court according to the conditions of his recognizance entered into and through the securities for his recognizance appearance from this recognizance and undertaking are discharged, and the parties being fully heard. The court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said Miles Reese find security for his good behaviour towards all the good citizens of this county the said Miles Reese in the sum of \$500 and two securities in the sum of \$250 each to be levied of their respective good and chattel lands, and tenements and to the said Governor for the use of the bond rendered - and in default thereof that he be committed to jail - whereupon the said Miles Reese with, Henry Barrow & Edwin Pettway his securities entered into and acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Excellency James Pleasant Esq. Governor or chief magistrate of this county & his successor in office for the time being himself in the sum of \$500 and his said securities in the sum of \$250 each to be levied of their respective good and chattel lands & tenements & to the said Governor for the use of the bond rendered - Yet upon this condition that if the said Miles Reese shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the good citizens of this county for the space of 12 calendar months from this day but more especially towards Nathl. Sturman of this county then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -

Governor or chief magistrate of this county & his successor in office for the time being himself in the sum of \$100 and his said securities in the sum of \$50 each to be levied of their respective good & chattel lands & tenements & to the said Governor for the use of the bond rendered - Yet upon this condition that if the said W. D. Pounce shall keep the peace & be of good behaviour towards all the good citizens of this county for the space of 12 calendar months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -
