Turner & others on Plaintiff & others blyg. Miles Glase is by the court appointed Guardian ad litem
to the infant defendants. This cause in which the court hath appointed Miles Glase Guardian ad
litem to the defendants came on this day by consent to be heard upon the bill and answer filed and
was argued by counsel by counsel. On consideration whereof the court with adjages, orders and
directs that William Turner, Carr Bowers and Benjamin Griffin or any two of them do attest
and set apart to the complainant Elizabeth widow of Ephraim Turner and her ^{legal} heirs their
part of the land whereof Ephraim Turner ~~et al~~ died possessed and in the best intentions as her
owner in the bill same, having regard to quantity & quality and that they or any two of them
do sell to the highest bidder upon a credit of nine months (except for so much as will pay the cost
of this suit out of the sale, which will be for cash) the land aforesaid subject to the exec of the
said Elizabeth, that of the purchase they take bond with good security in such way as
to enable them to carry this decree into effect. That of the rest proceed they do attest and
pay over one fourth to Lem Turner and wife in her right, one fourth part to Miles Glase and
his wife, in her right, one fourth part to Jonathan T. Griffin and his wife in her right, and
one fourth part equally between the infant defendants. That the said Commissioners or
such of them as may act, do convey the said land to the purchaser by a good & sufficient
act without warranty - but the court doth direct that male Guardians shall be appoin-
ted to the infant defendants. The said Commissioners are to bring the bond to which they may be called
into court to be filed subject to the further order of the court. - Liberty is reserved to the infant
defendants to shew cause if any they can against this decree within one year after they shall
respectively have arrived to ^{the} age - and the Commissioners are ordered to make report to the
court of their acting in order to a final decree -
