At a court of quarter session continued and held for the county of Southampton on the 20th of June 1856
Pres^d: Geo. Hines, Clk: Geo. B. Griffin & James A. Hooper, Esqrs.

Samuel Revele appeared in court and made oath that he was a regular soldier in the army of the United States during the late war and was acquainted with Robert V. John Scott, natives of this county and who were also regular soldiers. Served in the same regiment with him. They were privates in Capt. Thomas M. Nelson company, in the 10th Regiment of Infantry that they both died at Plattsburg in the State of New York, of Cholera - unmarried and without issue - That their father is dead and that Mary Scott their mother and Claiborne Scott their only brother are living and live at dawn which is sworn to be certified to the department of war.

Sprattley Williams produces to the court the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law on Ordinary Keepers that -

It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that the said Sprattley Williams is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.
