Habeas Facias

with a court held for the county of Southampton on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1827 in pursuance  
of an act of assembly entitled an act to explain and amend an act reducing into one the several  
acts concerning forcible entries & detainers passed the 12<sup>th</sup> of February 1824  
between Calvin B. Calais vs Mrs. Calais & wife & James Phillips - Upon a warrant to recover the possession  
of a certain Tenement containing 122 acres of land with the appurtenances lying and  
being in the county of Southampton - It appearing that the said warrant hath been duly  
executed according to the provision of the above recited act of assembly and that William B. Daugherty  
and Robert Goodwyn two Justices of the peace for the county aforesaid have been duly notified  
as by the said act required, and also that 18 good lawful men freeholders have been  
summoned as by the said act required - It is ordered that a Jury of 12 be selected by lot from the  
said freeholders - whereupon came a Jury to wit, Henry B. Vaughan, George B. Leary, Nathaniel  
Kochelle, James A. Holt, Amos Drake, Edwin Rice, Peter Sumner, Barham Mason, Benj<sup>n</sup>. Applewhite,  
Francis Clements, Henry Bonow & Henry Moor who being charged as the said act of assembly requires  
returned a verdict in the words following to wit, "We the Jury find that the defendants did  
at the time of the repetition of the complaint filed in this cause, hold possession  
of the Tenement therein mentioned against the consent of the plaintiff; that the  
said Defendants hath not held possession thereof against the consent of the plff  
for three years next next before the repetition of the said complaint, and that  
the plaintiff hath the right of possession in the Tenement aforesaid -  
Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the  
Defendants possession of the Tenement aforesaid & his costs by him in this be-  
half expended - and that the writ of Habeas Facias possession be awarded  
him returnable here &c - News That on the trial of this cause the said court  
filed two bills of exception which were signed & sealed by the court & ordered to be  
made a part of the record in this cause
