 this county and charged with the felony aforesaid (The court summoned for his examination not
 having met). and thereupon given evidence as sworn & examined on behalf of the Comd.
 Touching the premises with Mr. West, Langston Pierce, Miller Pracy, Riab Pracy, Lewis King Geo.
 Branch — and the prisoner being fully heard by A. Atkinson who was
 assigned by the court his counsel — The court after hearing the testimony and all the circum-
 stances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for said offence at the
 next Superior court to be holden for this county and thereupon it is ordered that he be removed
 to jail —

Be it remembered that William West, Langston Pierce, Miller Pracy, Riab Pracy, Lewis
 King Geo. Branch here in court acknowledges themselves to be indebted unto his Excellency
 Mr. B. Giles Esq. Governor or chief magistrate of this Comd. and his Successor in office for the

 condition that if they and each of them shall personally appear before the Judge of our

 behalf of the Comd. against Cromwell Simon who stands charged with Larceny and
 shall not depart thence without leave of the said court then the above obligation to be void
 otherwise to remain in full force & virtue —
