Moses a negro man Slave the property of Peyton Albion of the Town of Petersburg
 was this day set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county and charged with feloniously
 shooting John Browne of this county with an intention to maim wound & disfigure
 disable and kill him the said John Browne, and was thereof arraigned and upon
 his arraignment pleaded not guilty and for his trial put himself upon God and
 this court, and thereupon John Browne was sworn and examined as a witness on
 behalf of the com^t after being first sworn on the holy evangelist of Almighty God
 deposed & said that he with other went on a party of pleasure on the waters of Black
 water River after proceeding some distance they found a shoot on an Island killed and
 cleared, that they took possession of the shoot and some other articles which they found
 at the same place, and then returned up the river before they had proceeded far
 they were hailed and upon turning round they saw the prisoner at the bar who
 abused all the company, threatened shooting them & after a short time did shoot
 this defendant and by such shooting did put out the eye of this defendant and
 did inflict many other wounds on this defendant and the witness being thus
 closed and the prisoner fully heard by counsel. The court after hearing the testimony
 and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is guilty of
 the felony whereof he stands charged. Therefore it is ordered that he receive
 thirty nine lashes on his bare back well laid on and that he be banished
 and transported beyond the limits of the United States - and the court value the
 said slave to Three hundred Dollars -
