Upon the petitions of William G. Bogeman, a descendant of a female of the Potowmack Tribe of Indians. The Report of Jeremiah Webb a Commissioner specially appointed to ascertain the value of the interest of the s^r Bogeman & Turner in the estate real & personal held in trust for the said Tribe having been returned. The Court upon mature consideration adopting the principles of the said report agrees and sets apart to the said William G. Bogeman and Edith Turner four hundred and sixteen acres & one half acre of land bounded as follows. Beginning at a Spanish oak a corner between Henry Daugherty & the said thence by the said road to a new corner on said road (a black gum) thence North 46 degrees East 224 poles a new corner in the Indian land thence North 46 degrees East to the Mery or Rudy branch at Henry Daugherty's fence thence by the said fence and a line of marked trees to the beginning which said 416 1/2 acres lacks 3 1/2 acres of their quantity it is ordered that the Trustees of the Tribe pay the s^r Bogeman & Turner in money out of the personal estate for the s^r 3 1/2 acres at 44 dollars per acre which said land & and it appearing from the Law^r rep^r that the s^r Wm G. Bogeman & Edith Turner interest in the personal estate is

It is ordered the Trustees of the said Tribe pay to the s^r Bogeman & Turner the sum of ^{out of its funds}

And that the said Bogeman & Turner hold the land & money aforesaid as their individual & absolute property in full discharge of all their interest and claim in and to the trust estate real & personal aforesaid. The Court being of opinion that the said Edith Turner is a person of good moral

character & is not likely to become chargeable to any part of the Commonwealth and it is ordered that the costs of surveying the Indian land be paid by the party sued and the costs of surveying the same by the party sued Bogeman & Turner.
