Ordered that the proper process be paid by the several persons presented by the Grand Jury at this term, returnable here.

Nathaniel Rochelle, George H. Gray, William H. Fells, & Joseph Pireton who were summoned as Grand Jurors were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that that for their said contempt they be fined the sum of \$5. each unless sufficient cause of their inability to attend be shown at or before Aug. Court next.
