The account of Simon Marple as tutor of William Beale dec'd & as guardian to his orphans having been returned more than three months & no exceptions being filed thereto the same is confirmed by the Court & ordered to be recorded -

An Inventory & appraisement of Robert Forts est. ret'd &c. &c. Jones & Sons & Lehy. Report ret'd & confirmed by consent & costs to be equally borne &c.

An Account Current of Rich'd. Seary's admr. on Behalf Johnson's est. ret'd &c. &c.

A Certificate of the Deeds & admissions to record in the Clerk's Office since the last Court ret'd &c. to be entered among the days proceedings &c.

Admon on Peter Morris's est. is granted to John Warren who made oath & gave bond with security according to Law &c.

Ordered that Robert Drury, Drury Drunk, Thomas Kitchen & Mr. Johnson or any 3 appraise S. estate &c.

On the motion of Harriet Parker admr. of Henry Gardner dec'd. Ordered that Mr. Carr & Co. settle the said Parker's admr. act & make up &c.

Bello's admr. & Williams's admr. Lehy. Dec'd as per record filed &c.

Ramsay's admr. & Ramsay's admr. Lehy. Dec'd as per record filed &c.

Absent. Orin A. Brown. Present. Robert Goodwin Clerk.

John T. Blaw Jr. came into Court & resigned as a constable in the upper district of St. Luke's Parish, in this County.

On the petition of Orin A. Brown one of James Cooper's securities for his good ship of Joseph & Rich'd. Gilliam orphans of <sup>Joseph</sup> Henry R. Gilliam - This day the said Cooper appeared in discharge of the rule made against him at the last Court. & the petitioner as well as the said Cooper being heard it is ordered that the said Cooper give the said Brown counter security, the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of the bonds given by him as the h<sup>g</sup> and conditioned as the Law directs. And the said Cooper here in Court refusing to execute the said bond. he is by the Court displaced as h<sup>g</sup> aforesaid. And thereupon the said Joseph & Rich'd. Gilliam chose Benjamin Williamson for his Guardian & the said Richard A. Gilliam chose John B. Mason for his Guardian - who respectively gave bonds with security in the penalty of \$20,000 each, conditioned as the Law directs.
