woman of the County of Isle of Wight with being the father of her bastard child
now this day ^{appears} ~~present~~ into Court according to the condition of his recognizance.
And thereupon the said John Turner acknowledgeth himself to be the father of the
said bastard child, and the Court from the circumstances of the case doth adjudge
that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the said County of Isle of Wight
Therefore it is ordered that the said John Turner be charged with the annual
payment of fifteen dollars to the Overseers of the Poor for the County of Isle of
Wight, and that he pay the same to them accordingly at the end of every year
for the term of five years from the birth of the said child to wit from the
25th day of September 1820. Whereupon the said John Turner with Jonathan
Griffin & Benjamin B. Williams his securities here in Court acknowledged them-
selves indebted to his Excellency John Floyd Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia
the said John Turner in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and the said
Griffin & Williams in the sum of seventy five dollars each of their respective
goods and chattels lands and Tenements to be levied and to our said Governor & his
Successors for the use of the Commonwealth & ordered: Yet upon this condition that
if the said John Turner shall shall observe and perform the above order of the
Court made against him then the above recognizance to be void.
