At a Court of Quarterly Sessions held for Southampton County on the
Seventeenth day of August 1835-

An Account current and Commissioners report of Joel Loyals guardianship of John J. Henson was confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

An Account current Commissioners Report of Robert Andrews administration on Anthony Andrews estate was returned and continued for exceptions.

An Account current and Commissioners Report of Jesse S. Cox administration on John S. Cox estate was returned and continued for exceptions.

A Reformed account current and Commissioners report of Peter Edwards administration on Benjamin Edwards estate was returned and continued for exceptions.

A Deed of bargain and sale returned by the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day of July 1835 between Nelson Wilkins and his wife Martha of the one part and Sarah Jones of the other part was this day returned to and inspected by the Court and ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Drury & Dorothy his wife to Thomas & James Drury conveying One hundred and sixty acres of Land was acknowledged before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the first day of August 1835 by the said Benjamin Drury and together with a certificate thereof annexed of the being examination and acknowledgment of the said Dorothy admitted to record - which is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas & James to Emma, John & James Cooper children of John Cooper deceased by David D. Savage their guardian, conveying all the right in the lands slaves annexed and purchaseable estate which were of the estate of the said John Cooper dec^d and which accrued to Rebecca Cooper his widow was acknowledged before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day last and together with a receipt thereof annexed which was also acknowledged by the said Thomas & James admitted to record - is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Abraham Gardner to Thomas Butler, conveying a tract or parcel of land containing thirty eight acres was acknowledged by the said Abraham Gardner before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day last and admitted to Record - which is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale from John Cook and Polly his wife to Jeremiah Schappell conveying a tract or parcel of land containing by estimation One hundred and eighty six and a half acres was acknowledged by the said John Cook before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day last and together with the certificate thereof annexed of the being examination and acknowledgment of the said Polly admitted to record - which is ordered to be inserted among the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas & James & Martha his wife to Henry Lawrence conveying a certain Lot or parcel of Land situate near the Town of Seaboard was acknowledged by the said Thomas & James before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day of July last and together with the certificate thereof annexed of the being examination and acknowledgment of the said Martha admitted to record - which is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.

A Deed of bargain and sale between William A. Chickler and Meliza & his wife to Samuel Drury conveying a tract or parcel of land estimated to contain One hundred and twenty five acres was acknowledged by the said William A. Chickler before the Clerk of this Court in his Office on the 20th day of July last and together with the certificate thereof annexed of the being examination and acknowledgment of the said Meliza & admitted to record - which is ordered to be inserted in the minutes of the proceedings of the day.
