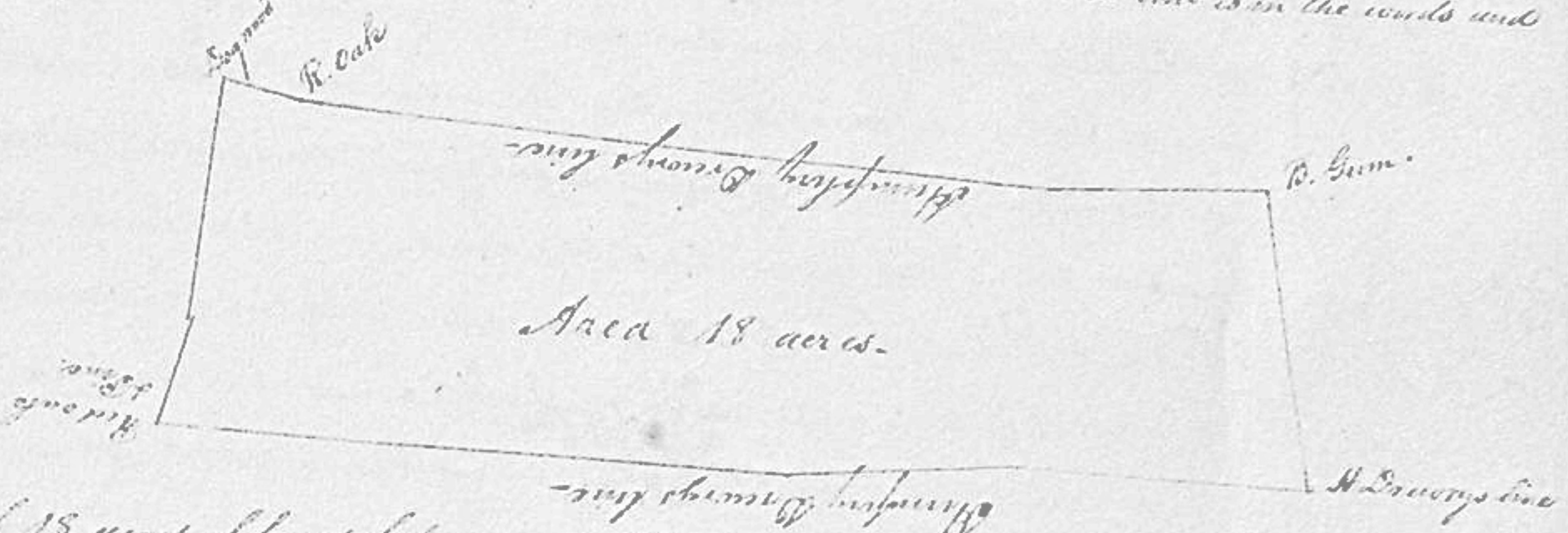

Bishop, Exum Woodard, David Dray, Joseph Japer and Benjamin Lamb were sworn a grand jury of inquest upon the body of the County and having received their charge withdrew and after sometime returned into Court and presented

The Millage Bridge across the head of John Dicks mill pond by the evidence of Samuel M. Bond and Gilbert Drury. And the Grand Jury having nothing further to present were discharged - William D. Bond Surveyor of this County this day returned a plat and certificate of a survey made by him of a part of a tract of land sold by the Sheriff as delinquent for the non payment of taxes due thereon and purchased by Henry Woodard, which plat and certificate are ordered to be recorded and is in the words and figures following to wit.



There is a plat of 18 acres of land belonging to Charles Harrison and sold by the Sheriff of Southampton County for the payment of taxes due on it and purchased by Henry Woodard for whom it was surveyed August 1. 1835. Commencing at a small logwood a corner of said land and the lands of May Drury and running S 8° W. 7.26 p. to a red oak in said Drury's line thence S 2° W 68 poles to a red oak thence S 3° E 19.64 poles to a R. Bond in branch thence S 85° W 27.35 poles to May Drury's line thence N 26° 40 poles thence N 6° W 20 poles thence N 36 poles to R. Bond's line all in May Drury's line thence S 77° E 16 poles thence S 57° E 20.76 p. to the beginning. W. D. Bond Surveyor.
