On the motion of Robert T. Hargrove for leave to alter the road running near his house. Ordered that Peter Edwards Joseph T. Cland & Joseph Dwyer being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view the way proposed for running said road as well as the present way and report to the Court the comparative conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such road be opened as proposed.
