

At a Court held for Southampton on the 21st day of September 1800.
Present James Clayton Samuel B Hines
Septia Landon and William A Sparks } Gent.

Let John R Edwards be appointed Clerk pro tempore of this Court to act until a Clerk shall be appointed to supply the vacancy created by the death of James Rochelle esq. Clerk.
Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the Peace for this County to the first day of October next to elect a Clerk to supply the vacancy created by the death of James Rochelle esq. Clerk of this Court.

Absent William A Sparks Present James Mayes Gent.
Ordered that Alexander Myrick guardian of John Eliza Fitzhugh be allowed to use so much of the principle of his said wards estate as will satisfy an account due George & Samuel Mellers amounting to twenty dollars seventy five cents -
Patrick B and Hanson & Harrell

against
James Gray assignee guardian ad litem to James Harrell and William Harrell infant Legatee of David Harrell.

This day this cause was docketed by consent of parties and came on to be heard on the bill answer and exhibits and was argued by counsel. It hereupon the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Benjamin L Dyer Robert Prethor and Edmund Williford or any two of them proceed accompanied by the County Surveyor of this County to divide the real estate of David Harrell dec^d taking into consideration the two Stills mentioned in the 16th Clause of said Testators Will which will be added to the value of the said real estate and on account of the use and occupancy of the room and houses as bequeathed to his daughter Irena allowance will be made to the dwelling house portion so as to make it in all respects of equal value with the other three although subject to the restriction aforesaid and having thus divided the said real estate into four equal portions with regard to value thereof and establish the same by notes and bonds with the assistance of the said Surveyor they assign by Lot one fourth thus ascertained to Patrick B. one fourth to Hanson & Harrell one fourth to James Harrells guardian in right of his ward, and the other fourth to the guardian of William Harrell in right of his ward. And the Court doth further order and decree that the expenses of this decree be defrayed jointly by the parties hereto. And that the aforesaid Commissioners report to this Court how they have executed this decree in order for a final decree.

On the motion of Rebecca Holloman. Ordered that Nicholas M Sebell administrator debitorum of Peter Simmons dec^d do render an account of his administration on his Testators estate before Master Commissioner Cobb who is directed to examine State and settle the same and make report thereof to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be requested to state.

Ordered that the account of James B Sebell jailor amounting to sixty seven dollars & sixty three cents be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

The last Will and Testament of James Rochelle dec^d was proved by the oath of William A Sparks Clements Rochelle and Minny Doyal the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. and on the motion of Martha Rochelle the executrix therein named who made oath and together with George Blon William A Sparks and Samuel B Hines her Securities entered into and acknowledged bonds in the penalty of Sixty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
Ordered that William C Parker Stephen Mardrough John L Turner James T French and Nicholas M Sebell or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace do truly and justly appraise all the personal and real estate of James Rochelle dec^d.
