This cause this day came on to be heard by consent of parties and was argued by counsel upon the bill, answer exhibits &c. whereupon the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Benwell, Bennett, Matthew Barnes, Lewis A Branch and Eli Barker Commissioners hereby appointed, any three of whom may act, do proceed after publication of Sale for a reasonable time at some public place to sell to the highest bidder all that tract or parcel of land on a credit of twelve months, except such sum for cash as may be necessary to pay expenses - which Mary Barnes the widow of Joshua Barnes received from her father by Deed, and that they take bonds with good security for the sum of money arising from the sale thereof in the following proportions, One for one fourth payable to William West, one for one fourth payable to Sally Stephens one for one fourth payable to Robert, James & Joseph West and Sally Britt children of John West and One for one fourth payable to Nancy West, Talbert West and James West children of James West dec<sup>d</sup> and having performed this return their proceedings to this Court in order to a final decree -

Ordered that the estate of John Law dec<sup>d</sup> be committed to the hands of Benjamin Denny Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

Ordered that James Clayton, Benjamin Griffin, Wilbourn Stephenson and Benjamin Baxter or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of John Law dec<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court. This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and came on to be heard on the bill, answer and exhibits whereon the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that James Clayton Wilbourn Stephenson, Benjamin Griffin and Robert Denny or any three of them proceed to allot to the widow of John Law dec<sup>d</sup> (Patsy Law) one third of the real estate of which John Law dec<sup>d</sup> died possessed, with regard to the value thereof as her dower in said real estate, and make sale of the said real estate subject to the widows dower as aforesaid on a credit of not exceeding twelve months taking bond and approved security for the payment of this and purchase money and assign to Jery Law, Jeph & Sedbetter Law, Jery Spring in right of his wife Rufia, and Gordonson Warren in right of his wife Nancy one sixth each of the proceeds of said sale and one sixth to the guardian of any of Polly Law infant of John Law - and if the said Polly has no guardian then to return the bond for her proportion to this Court. And it is further decreed that they sell for cash, and the purchase of said land is required to pay cash for said purchase so far as is necessary to defray the expenses of this decree.
