

Present George A. C. Washburn Gent.
John Gardner who stands committed to the Jail of this County charged with breaking the house and chest of Elizabeth Stone and feloniously stealing taking and carrying away seventy five dollars in specie, was set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the Jail of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed to mat) whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the examination of the said John Gardner is adjourned till tomorrow.
Hall a negro man slave belonging to John A. Turner who stands committed to the Jail of this County charged with unlawfully, maliciously and feloniously assaulting and beating Nathan B. Bryant of this County on the 2^d day of September 1855 with intention or so doing, wilfully, maliciously and feloniously to kill him the said Nathan B. Bryant, was this day set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the Jail of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed to mat) whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the trial of the said Hall is continued till tomorrow.
Holladay Vick who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of John Reville against him for breach of the peace this day appeared accordingly and the Court ordered that the said complaint be dismissed.
George Howe Gent. who has been duly licensed to practice the law in the Courts of this Commonwealth on his motion has leave to practice in this Court and thereupon he took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth and the oath of an attorney at law.

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On the motion of Jenny Beecher Ordered that she be allowed to draw the interest arising out of any moneys or funds deposited with the Clerk of this Court as a compensation for the support of her infant children.

On the motion of Henry P. Briggs setting forth that she is bound in this Court as security for Phoebe English for her due and faithful administration of her deceased husband Frances P. English's estate, and that he concurs himself in danger of suffering thereby and praying the Court for relief. It was ordered that the said Phoebe English be summoned to appear here on the first day of December Court next to, show cause if any she can why she should not be ruled to give the Henry P. Briggs good counter security or execute a new bond with security according to law.

The Court are unanimous in recommending Benjamin Griffin, James D. Hopkinson, and Thomas Satter Gent. to the Governor of this Commonwealth as fit and proper persons to execute the Office of Sheriff of this County the ensuing year.

The registers of James Taylor, Simons Artist, Alfred Diggs, Caroline Black, Benjamin Austin, and Amy Liberty were examined and certified to be truly made.

Ordered that the account of James H. Seibull factor amounting to nine dollars twenty five and one third cents be certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.

Ordered that the promissory note of the Grand jury made against John Bryant of John for felony be certified to a Justice of the peace for this County to be proceeded on according to law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 O'clock.
