Whereupon the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Elizabeth Williams, John Woodard and Peter D. Beckman be appointed Commissioners, any two of whom may act - that they do divide and allot to the administrator of James Coleman one third part of the personal estate of her deceased husband in right of dower and make report to this Court how they have executed this decree in order to a final decree -

William Harris guardian to Zachariah Doyal this day returned an account of his guardianship and made affirmation thereof according to law, which account is ordered to be recorded -

On the motion of William Harris for leave to alter the Quarter Road near his house - The parties heretofore appointed to view the way proposed for the said road to run this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Pursuant to the annexed order, we the undersigned have been in the new road as proposed to be opened by William Harris, and also viewed the present road now in use, and we are of opinion that the ground where the new road is opened is higher than where the old road runs, and that the distance is shortened about fifty yards in a quarter of a mile, which is about the length of the new road, and we are of the opinion that the individuals will be materially benefitted, as it saves a considerable number of rails. And we are also of the opinion that the public will be benefitted, as the land is higher where the new road is proposed to be run, and the distance shorter - so in the whole all parties will be benefitted. Given under our hands this 9th day of December 1835. Nathaniel Turner, Benj. Griffin, Zachariah Doyal & James." And it is ordered that the petitioners have leave to alter the road as proposed and that the old road be discontinued from the time the new road is opened and put in good repair.
