Turner his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. which bond is ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth assign Elizabeth Hines guardian to Georgian Hines orphan of George Hines deceased and thereupon the said Elizabeth Hines together with John D. Turner and Samuel B. Smith his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

On the motion of River Barker against James Myrick. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendant hath legal notice of this motion he was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant the sum of Seventy three dollars and forty four cents with Interest thereon from the 16th day of November 1835 till paid. it being the amount which the plaintiff has been compelled to pay by execution to Robert Reichelt Jr. Trustee who sold for Benjamin Williamson, as security for the Defendant, and also that the plaintiff recover against the defendant his costs by him in this behalf expended. And the said Defendant on Merit & P.

The persons heretofore appointed to let the repairs of the bridge across a gut near Blows mill pond this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Agreeably to an order of the Honorable Court of Southampton, August 1835. we the Commissioners have proceeded to let the repairs of the bridge near led. Blows mill, which was undertaken by Benjamin Mann for the sum of twenty eight dollars and thirty cents. the same is completed agreeable to contract. Ordered that George G. Gray, A. L. H. Briggs and Lewis A. Branch bring down before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to view the way proposed for the said and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such road be opened as proposed.

Nathaniel Simmons the Executor named in the last Will and Testament of Joseph Rice dec. heretofore proved and recorded in this Court, this day appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution of the said Will. Therefore it is ordered that the estate of the said Joseph Rice dec. be committed to the hands of Benjamin Devany Sheriff of this County for administration
