 and receives from Lot N^o 1 the sum of \$550. All of which is submitted to your wisdom and heard
 the 16th day of January 1836. Pope Parker, Samuel R. Gardner, Meredith Holland.
 Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the division of said slaves
 as made shall be held firm and stable and binding between the parties and that the sale to
 equally have between the said parties.
