Ordered that he be allowed to use fifty dollars annually exclusive of the interest of their money to be appropriated to the education and support of the said wards - and that he be allowed to use thirty five dollars annually inclusive of the interest of her money to be applied to the support maintenance of Margaret A. Gardner.

An indenture of bargain and sale from John Shephard and Susan his wife to James Dwyer was returned and together with the certificates thereto annexed ordered to be recorded.

An account of Joseph Senors guardianship of Henrietta Senor was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Benjamin Griffin who has been appointed Sheriff of this County for the ensuing year by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth this day came into Court and together with Samuel B. Hines, Robert Ricks, Patrick Dole, Jesse Parker, Lewis St. Branch and Clements Rochelle his associates entered into three several bonds in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars each conditioned as the law directs which bonds were acknowledged by the obligors thereto and ordered to be recorded.

Ederin Williams having obtained an attachment against the estate of Cooper Williams who has absconded or so conceals himself that the ordinary process of Law cannot be served upon him, and the Sheriff having returned that he had attached in the hands of Jesse Dwyer one silver watch. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant altho' solemnly called came not. It is therefore considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of thirty dollars seventy five cents the amount of his debt proved to be just with legal interest thereon from the 20th day of January 1830 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And it is ordered that the Sheriff make sale of the aforesaid attached effects and out of the monies arising therefrom pay and satisfy the aforesaid judgment to the plaintiff and the surplus if any restore to the defendant and return an account of such sale to the next Court.

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
