

Be it remembered that John Vaughan Joseph Black and James H Love here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to Lottelie M Fitzgerald Esquire Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of One hundred dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth. Yet upon this condition that if the said Vaughan Black & Love shall severally personally appear before the Judge of our Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for this County on the first day of March Term then and there to give such evidence as they or either of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Henry Drury who stands charged with felony and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

James Felts who stands committed to the Jail of this County for feloniously Stealing taking and carrying away on the 7 day of December 1835 one certain hog or swine the property of Nancy Pope within this County was set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County (the Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet) Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner by his counsel fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next quarterly Court to be held for this County. And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to Jail.

Be it remembered that Nancy Pope Mills Pope and Peter Pope here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to Lottelie M Fitzgerald Esquire Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of One hundred dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors in Office to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Nancy Pope Mills Pope and Peter Pope shall severally personally appear before the Justice of the County Court of Southampton at the Court house on the first day of March Court next then and there to give such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Lewis Felts and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Joseph Tolland a Justice of the Peace of this County this day returned an examination of Maria Ann Norton of this County single woman taken before him in writing upon oath upon which examination the said Maria Ann Norton charged Benjamin Williamson with being the father of her bastard child: the said Justice also returned a warrant issued by him upon application made to him by Edwin Bland one of the Overseers of the poor of this County for the apprehension of the said Benjamin Williamson together with a recognizance entered into by the said Benjamin Williamson to appear here and to abide and perform such Order as the Court should make concerning the same. Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the case is continued till the next Court.

On the motion of Sugars Davis guardian to Elizabeth Ann Wellons and it appearing to the Court that the property of the said Wellons estate is chargeable and insufficient for its own support. It is ordered that the said guardian be permitted to make sale of a negro slave named Peter belonging to his said Wellons after giving reasonable notice of the time and place of sale and take bond and security of the purchaser for the payment of the purchase money except sufficient to pay the costs of these proceedings which will be for cash and make report thereof to this Court.

The Court doth assign Thomas Le Jones guardian to Louisa Virginia Percepsie, Leurgus, Cardine & Angerine Clements orphans of Moses Clements deceased and thereupon the said Thomas Le Jones together with James Mayet and John Le Turner his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifty dollars conditioned according to Law.

Mills Summer is to supply the vacancy in the office of Justice of the Peace for the County of Southampton. Thomas Le Jones and five thousand dollars also took the oath of office for the County of Southampton.

On the motion of Lottelie M Fitzgerald Esquire deputy during his absence from the County of Southampton the Court doth order the said Lottelie M Fitzgerald to be sworn in as Justice of the Peace for the County of Southampton.
