Ordered that Master Commissioner Briggs examine state and settle an account of Polly B. Butts guardianship of George Butts dec^d and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be requested to state.

This day came the parties by their counsel, and the commissioners appointed by the Interlocutory decree made in this cause at January Court last to make allotment and Sale of the slaves then mentioned this day made the following report to wit: "In obedience to the above order, we have proceeded to divide and make Sale of the negroes belonging to the Est. of Charles Stevenson dec^d and have allotted to Mrs. Nancy Worrell formerly the widow of Charles Stevenson a negro girl named Wasing, supposed to be worth five hundred - The remaining negroes Eve & Sarah we exposed to public Sale, who brought the amount of Eight hundred and fifty dollars - which amount divided in three equal portions - (one to Abner R. Stephenson, one to John D. Stephenson & one to Virginia A. Edwards) entitled each legatee to the sum of Two hundred and eighty three dollars and thirty three & a third cents - For which amount we have taken about payable six months after date (1st Feb^y) and paid over to Abner R. Stephenson, one to Richard Darden guardian for John D. Stephenson one, & Peter Edwards Guard. for Virginia A. Edwards one. The decree not directing us to sell either for cash or upon a credit, we thought it most prudent to consult the wishes of the parties interested, who concluded upon the length of credit for which the property was sold - Respectfully Submitted to the Court. James M. Parker. Nathan Pope. Amos Stephenson." Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered the Sale and division of said negroes and form as aforesaid made to hold firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties.
