

But this execution may be discharge by the payment of fifty-three dollars and sixteen cents with legal interest thereon from the 15th day of November 1835 till paid and the bill.

On the motion of Samuel Cabot who made oath and together with Benjamin Denny and Joseph C. Reed his servants, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Martha Mellickin and in due form.

Ordered that Samuel F. Nicholson, Samuel Polkirkhorn, David Goddard, Nicholas A. Sebell and James H. Sebell or any three of them, being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Martha Mellickin and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

The last Will and Testament of Richard Crocker deceased was proved by the oaths of Thomas Swain and Henry Allen two of the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of William M. Crocker the only Executor therein named, who made oath and together with Peter Casarides and Nathaniel Francis his servants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that Master Commissioner, do examine, state and settle an account of John Caum's administration on the Estate of Rebecca Caum and report the same to this Court with any matters deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On motion of Henry Pons and Lewis St. Branch for leave to open a new road from the Smithfield road near the corner of Shadrach Boykin's fence to strike the Cedar Point Road near Lewis St. Branch's. The persons through whose Land the said Road is proposed to be run having been summoned and not appearing, and there not being a majority of the Justices present. Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the Justices of the County to the next Court to take the subject under consideration.

Ordered that the Estate of James Mountford decd. be committed to the hands of Benjamin Denny Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.
