John Bacon. Matter of Biddle. "In pursuance to the annexed decree we have appraised and divided the Negroes belonging to the estate of Colthorp Jones decd. after selling a part of the Negroes for the purpose of fulfilling the bequests of said decree, we find that Archer J. Bond is entitled to the following Negroes to wit: Rose, Clements, Arrey, Eliza, Dree & Nancy and that Hawkins Bond pay to the said Archer J. Bond the sum of Eighty Nine dollars & 0 cents and that we have allotted Hawkins Bond one Negro man firm. John Bacon. Matter of Biddle." Therefore by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered, that the division aforesaid in form aforesaid in form aforesaid made; be held firm and stable and binding between the parties and that the land be equally borne between the said parties.

A Deed of bargain & sale from John Store to James Scott, was acknowledged by the said John Store, and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Jacob Jordan who affirmed and together with John C. Turner and Darden M. Bryant his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Margaret Vick decd. in due form.

Ordered that Joshua Vick, Nancy Nagel, Matthew Vick and Joel Vick or any three of them, being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Margaret Vick, decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

The Court with assign Benjamin Barham Guardian to Emeline Davis his daughter, and Robert Davis orphan of Robert Davis decd. and thereupon the said Benjamin Barham together with Nicholas J. Barham and Tibulau L. Simmons his securities entered into and acknowledged two bonds each for one thousand dollars & conditioned as the Law directs.

John Gardner, who stands committed to the Jail of this County charged with feloniously breaking and entering the House & Chest of Elizabeth Screws, and stealing taking and carrying away from thence one brown lined bag containing one hundred and fifty half dollars in specie, the property of the said Elizabeth Screws, was set to the bar in custody of the Jail or of this Court. (The Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet) and thereupon sundry Witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner by his Counsel fully heard. The Court, after hearing the evidence and from all the circumstances of the case, are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried, for the said offence, at the next Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery to be held for this County. And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to Jail.

Be it remembered that Thomas R. Gray, Elizabeth Screws, John Bishop and Mills Sumner here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Lottator M. Tazewell Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$100 each of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and
