

his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered: But upon the condition that if the said Lord, Secord, Bishop & Somner shall severally make their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for this County on the first day of the next Term to give such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against John Gardner who stands charged with felony and shall not depart thence without leave of the Court then the above obligation to be void or otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.

Hall, a negro man Slave, who stands charged with wilfully, maliciously & feloniously assaulting with an intent to kill Nathan B. Bryant a free White citizen of this Commonwealth on or about the 22nd day of September 1835 and within this County (The Court summoned for his examination having failed to meet.) Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the trial of the said Hall is adjourned till the next Court.

The Certificate of the Register of Allen Whappell, William Bailey, Mike Roberts & Archer Cross, free Negroes, were examined and certified to be correct.

On motion of Bailey Bryant who made oath and together with Benjamin Lamb and James D. Bryant his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars, conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Samuel D. Bryant deceased in due form.

Ordered that Benjamin Lamb, Thomas Ridley Jr., James M. Parker and Amos Stephenson or any three of them, being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Samuel D. Bryant decd and return the appraisement under their hands to this Court.

On motion of Shugars Laine, who made oath and together John Cozum and Patrick Dole his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars, conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Mary Mooters deceased in due form.

John H. Newsum orphan of John Newsum decd, with the approbation of the Court, made choice of William Doyal for his Guardian, who together with Allison Doyal and baswell Morrel his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars, conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
