James L. Maffertburg is appointed curator of James, Lilly, Tabatha, Solomon, Heaton, Elizabeth, Ellen and Joanna Johnson orphans of Ichabod Johnson decd.

Ordered that Benjamin Lamb be added to the Commissioners appointed at the Last Court to view and report to the Court a suitable site for the bridge across the Notaway River at Jerusalem and of the propriety of changing or altering the Road.

The Commissioners appointed to act with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Saratoga in relation to the Bridge at South Quay, this day made the following report. "The undersigned, Commissioners appointed by the Court of Saratoga in relation to the bridge over the Blackwater River at South Quay, beg leave most respectfully report, that they met together at South Quay and proceeded, in connection with the Commissioners of Saratoga, to ascertain whether the span arch of the said bridge could be so enlarged as to admit the navigation of said River by Steam Boats and other vessels, the extent of such enlargement, and the expenses that would be incurred in effecting the enlargement: And concurring unanimously with said Commissioners, they are of opinion that the span arch of said bridge may be enlarged to the requisite extent; that it would be proper to extend the span of the said arch at least four feet; and that one hundred and fifty dollars will be adequate to the prosecution of the work. All of which is respectfully submitted. L. D. Maffertburg, Jesse Parker, James Moor." And it is ordered that all the Justices of this County be summoned to the next Court to consider the propriety of enlarging the span arch of the said bridge as recommended by the Commissioners.

Hall, a negro Man Slave the property of John A. Turner, of this County, who stands committed to the jail of this County charged with wilfully, malicious and feloniously assaulting with an intention to kill Nathan B. Bryant a free white citizen of this Commonwealth on or about the 22nd September 1835 and within this County was again set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County and being thereof arraigned pleaded Not guilty. Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined, and the prisoner was fully heard by Thomas A. Gray Esq. his counsel. The Court after hearing the evidence and upon mature deliberation thereof are unanimously of opinion that the prisoner is guilty of the offence with which he stands charged; and it being demanded of him if any thing for himself he had or knew to say why the Court should not proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law, and nothing being offered in delay of judgment. It is considered by the Court that the prisoner be hanged by the neck until he be dead, and that the Sheriff of this County cause execution of this judgment to be done upon the said Hall on Friday the 29th day of April 1836 between the hours of ten o'clock in the forenoon and three o'clock in the afternoon of the same day. And the Court recommend to the Executive to commute the punishment of the said Hall to one and fifty dollars.
