At a Court continued by adjournment and held for the County of Southampton on the 19th day of April 1806 upon the examination of Bryant Edwards of this County charged with wilfully, malicious and feloniously stabbing Adams Jones.

The Court being thus constituted the said Bryant Edwards was again set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County. Whereupon for reasons appearing, the examination of the said Bryant Edwards is adjourned till the next Court to be held for this County. And on the motion of the said Bryant Edwards he is allowed to give bail—himself to be bound in the sum of one hundred dollars and two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each. And thereupon the said Bryant Edwards with Richmona Edwards & Spikes Deal his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Myndham Robertson Esq. Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia discharging the functions of Governor, that is to say the said Bryant Edwards in the sum of one hundred dollars and his securities in the sum of fifty dollars each of their goods & chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to worth render. Yet upon this condition that if the said Bryant Edwards shall make his personal appearance before this Court on the first day of the next Term to stand his trial for the offence of which he stands charged and shall do and leave of the said Court, then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.
