

Grant that Ann Nicholson be exempt from the payment of taxes and fines for her negroes, Billy, Jerry and ally, they being aged and infirm.

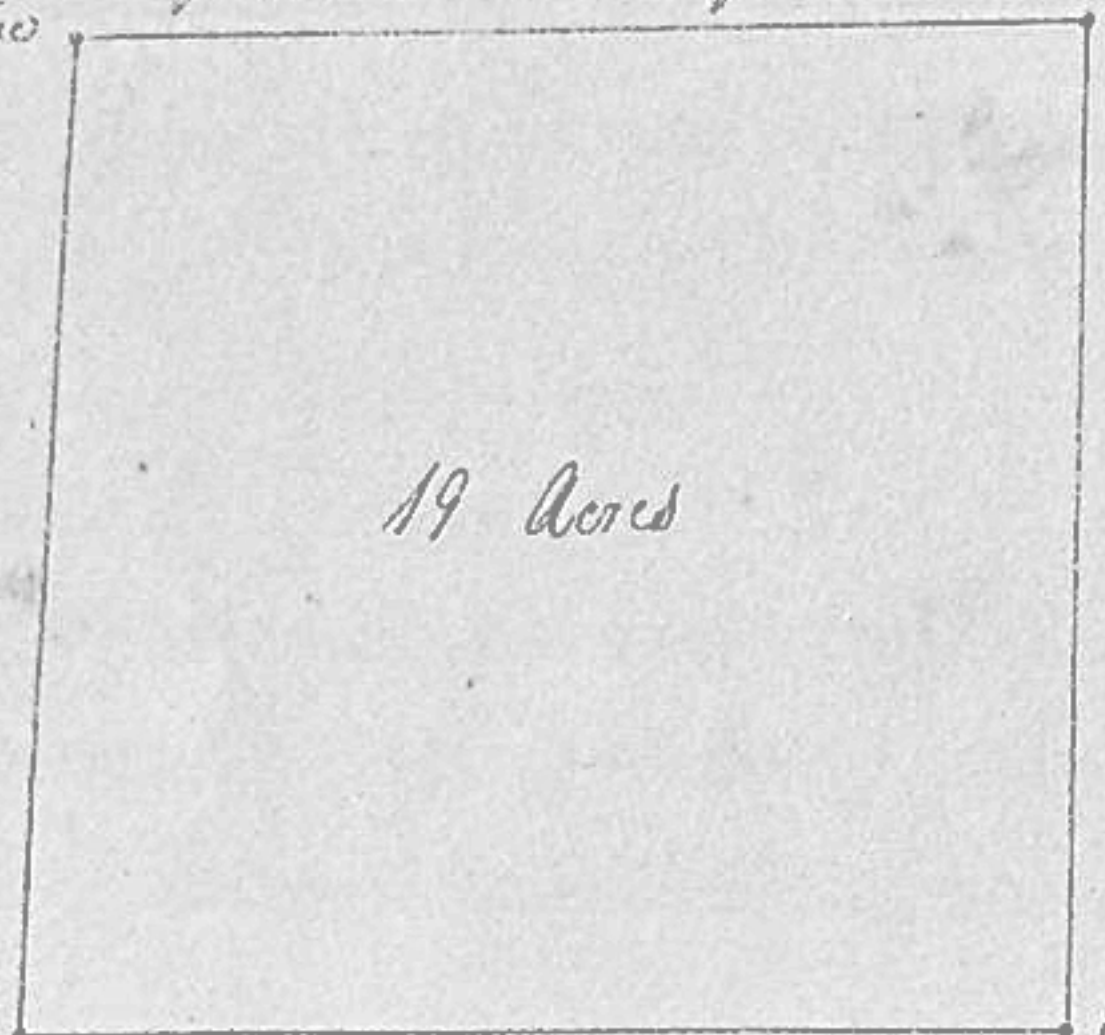

Williams who produces the Sheriff's Receipt for the tax imposed by law, a license is granted him to keep an ordinary at his House in this County until the next May term of this Court, upon his giving bond and security, in the clerk's office, according to Law: the Court being satisfied that the said Jacob J. Williams is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

The Registers of Alfred Joo and Tom Smith, free negroes, were examined and certified to be truly made.

Hill being the owner. — Commencing at a small red oak a corner of Elias Loo and running N. 86° E. 53.72 poles to a pine at corner of said tract and Exam Spring in Henry Pond's line thence N. 5° W. along to Pond's line 56.56 poles to a new made corner in said Pond's line, thence S. 5° E. 56.56 p. to the beginning, containing 19 acres, the quantity directed to be cut off." On the motion of Permelia Byrd, and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the indentures binding Myatt Byrd, Burwell Byrd, John Byrd and Mary Ann Byrd, free negroes, and children of the said Permelia Byrd, to James C. Harrison, which have since, by an order of the Court ordered to be transferred to Mary J. Harrison, be cancelled and made void, and that the said children be delivered to the care custody & control of the said Permelia Byrd, by the Sheriff of this County, to be retained by her till the 20th day of December next. Whereupon Mary J. Harrison who appeared by her attorney and opposed the motion, offered to file her exceptions, but the Court believing she has no right to except refused her permission to file her exceptions.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next term.
